With *Glass Worldwide* as official journal, leading personalities from South East Asia's regional glass communities came together in September to meet their peers and international suppliers at the ASEAN Glass Conference staged by the Vietnam Glass Association (Vieglass) in the picturesque city of Nha Trang, Vietnam.
