



40th ASEAN Glass Conference

The landmark 40th ASEAN Glass Conference was successfully staged last October in Thailand by the Glass Manufacturers Industry Club, The Federation of Thai Industries (GMFTI). The ASEAN Federation of Glass Manufacturers (AFGM) also used the occasion to announce Viwat Supatham as AFGM Chairman and the renewal of *Glass Worldwide* as exclusive official AFGM journal.

Adopting the theme 'A New Era of Collaboration', the 40th ASEAN Glass Conference took place for the first time in Hua Hin. A combination of technical and social events brought together approximately 360 attendees from 28 different countries in Africa, Asia, Europe, the Middle

East, North America and Oceania. Fifty attendees were first time participants.

With Thailand in a period of mourning for King Bhumibol Adulyadej, the organising committee followed guidelines from the Thai Government and Bureau of the Royal Household and amended the event programme accordingly to reflect the country's mood. Attendees dressed in black or white as appropriate mourning attire to express their condolences and observed a minute's silence in honour of the King of Thailand. "Our King passed away on 13 October, shocking all Thai

people with deepest sadness in the heart" lamented GMFTI Chairman and incoming AFGM Chairman, Viwat Supatham.

With appropriate tones, a golf tournament and cocktail reception took place before a grand conference opening that included a keynote speech from Chen Numchaisiri (Chairman of the Thai Federation of Thai Industries and Appointed Member of The National Legislative Assembly) and welcome addresses from Viwat Supatham, Worawit Sureesarakorn (Organising Conference Chairman) and Chai Kung Fee (outgoing AFGM Chairman).>

AFGM CHAIRMAN AND 2017 CONFERENCE ANNOUNCED

The AFGM used the occasion to hold a plenary session for members, where it was confirmed that the 41st ASEAN Glass Conference would be staged in Vietnam in September or October 2017. Further information will follow in a future issue of *Glass Worldwide* when available.

Also during the plenary session, Viwat Supatham was voted in as AFGM Chairman for 2017/18, succeeding Chai Kung Fee. "At present, the AFGM consists of five member nations, namely Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam. As per our policy, the chairmanship is elected every two years by the members and I am pleased to introduce our new elected AFGM Chairman, Viwat Supatham. I hope everyone will continue to give their full support to Khun Viwat in executing his heavy roles and responsibility" said Mr Chai, Executive Chairman of Glasco. "I have had the privilege of being AFGM Chairman for the past two years, receiving all kinds of support and encouragement from members and our associates. I would like to say thank you to everyone as without your support, it would not have been an easy task to accomplish my role."

Mr Viwat, General Manager of Siam Glass Industry Co Ltd, told Glass Worldwide: "It is an honour for me to be appointed AFGM Chairman for the next two years by our member countries. As AEC is on full track now, I believe we must stay stronger together in our collaboration, not only among members but all the glass people and friends around the world as one big family.

"The AFGM Conference was purposely designed to differentiate from any other glass conference in the world; at no other glass meeting can you talk on the poolside nor during a party" Mr Viwat added. "The four days we stay together annually for the last 40 years is incomparable when building such strong relationships."

Worawit Sureesarakorn, Plant Manager of Siam Fiberglass Co Ltd, was elected AFGM General Secretary for the same period, succeeding Nelson Hui Yuen Kin.
